Merchandise Trade November 2015

Highlights of the month

Exports

- Exports¹ were valued at \$13.1 million, decreasing 9.4 percent (\$1.4 million) from October 2015
- Exports of Food & Live animal products recorded the largest decrease (down \$1.1 million).
- Machinery & Transport Equipment exports became the top commodity groups exported during November, representing 37 percent of total exports.
- Exports to New Zealand increased 18.1 percent to \$2.1 million while exports to American Samoa decreased 24.0 percent to \$2.1 million from October 2015.

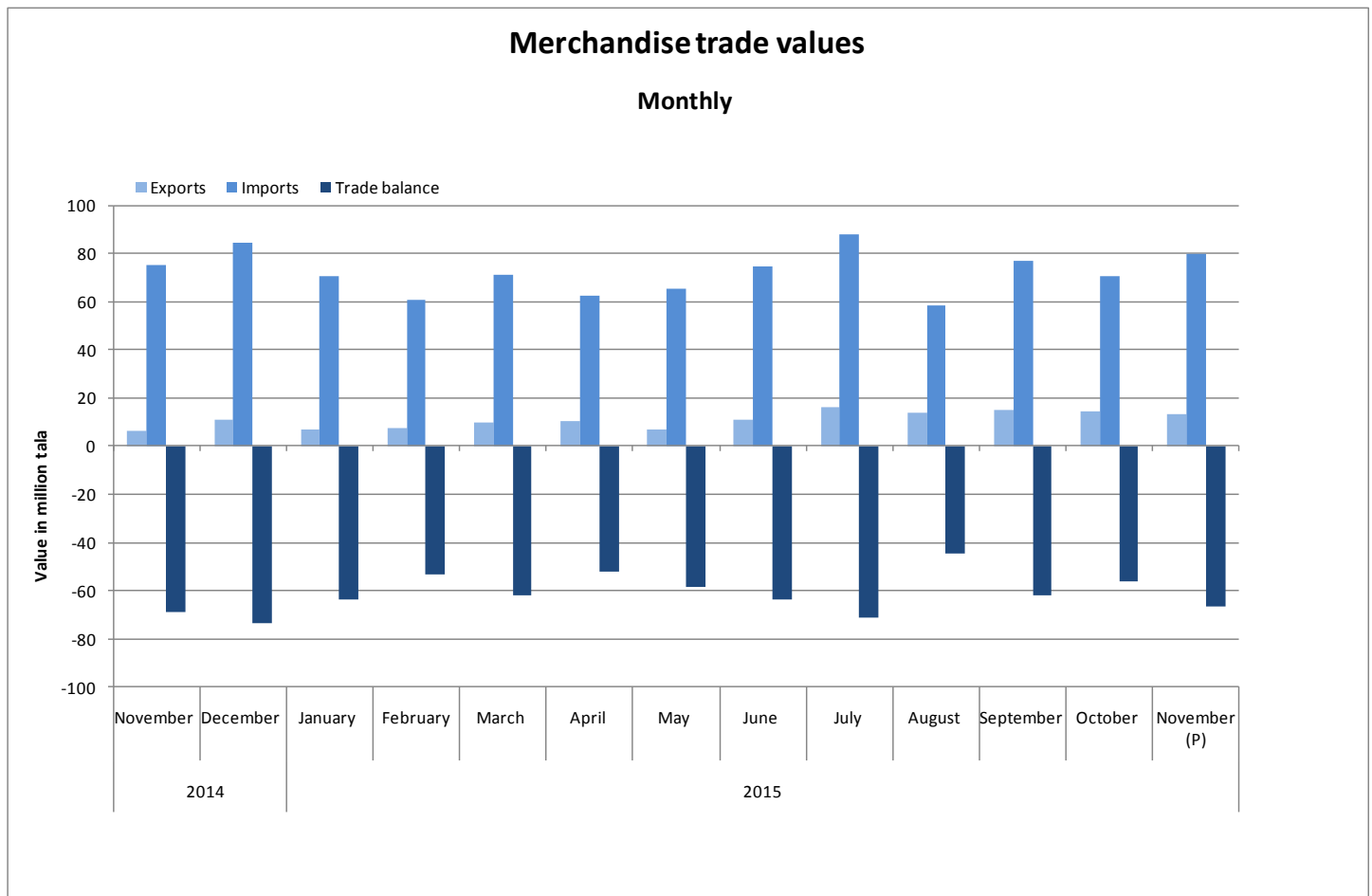
Imports

- Imports were valued at \$79.5 million, increasing 12.4 percent (\$8.8 million) from October 2015.
- Imports of Machinery & Transport Equipment recorded the largest increase (up \$5.1 million).
- Food and Live animals imports maintained the largest share of all commodity groups imported during November 2015, representing 25.3 percent of total imports.
- Imports from New Zealand increased 6.7 percent to \$20.6 million and Fiji rose 15.4 percent to \$7.1 million from October 2015

Trade Balance

- The value of imports (\$79.5 million) exceeded that of exports (\$13.1 million), resulting in a trade deficit of \$66.4 million.
