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### **IMPORT PRICE INDEX – QUARTER 2 2013**

**(Base Period: Quarter 1 2009 = 100.0)**

Issue No. 12

*Date: 31<sup>st</sup> July 2013*

The Import Price Index (MPI) measures changes in the cost, insurance, and freight (CIF) prices of imports of merchandise into Samoa. It is a fixed weights index with Quarter 1 2009 = 100.0 and is calculated on a quarterly basis using the International Harmonized System of Trade Classification (HS). The items included in the index were selected on the basis of their importance to the total import.

The scope of the MPI relates to the following sections of the International Harmonized System of Trade Classification (HS): 1. Live Animals: Animal Products, 2. Vegetable Products, 3. Animal or Vegetable fats and oils, 4. Food and Beverages and 5. Mineral Products. The index represents 50 percent of total imports.

Index numbers for each of the five Sections of its HS, and their ten major component chapters, are presented in Table 2.

HS Section percentage changes for Quarter 2 2013 over Quarter 2 of 2012 are displayed in Table 1. The percentage changes for Quarter 2 2013 over the previous quarter are summarized below.

**HS Section 1: Live Animals; Animal Products: -0.9%**

Prices of mutton (flaps and necks), milk and butter decreased.

**HS Section 2: Vegetable Products: -1.3%**

Prices of onions, rice and flour decreased.

**HS Section 3: Animal or Vegetable fats & oils: -0.5%**

Prices of vegetable oil and margarine decreased.

**HS Section 4: Food and Beverages: -0.2%**

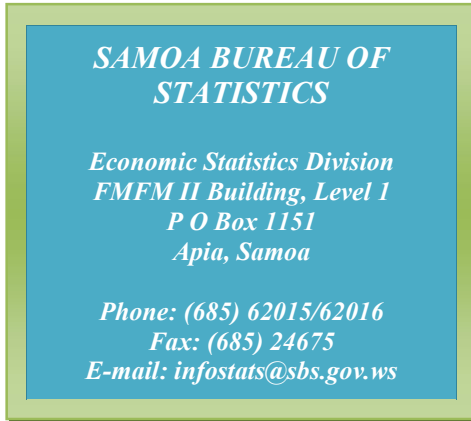
Prices of sugar (white and brown) instant noodles, macaroni and pastry decreased

**HS Section 5: Mineral Products: -5.6%**

Prices of petrol, kerosene and diesel decreased.

*Note: Because of recent difficulties in obtaining information from importers, a portion of the index is imputed based on information from other importers.*
