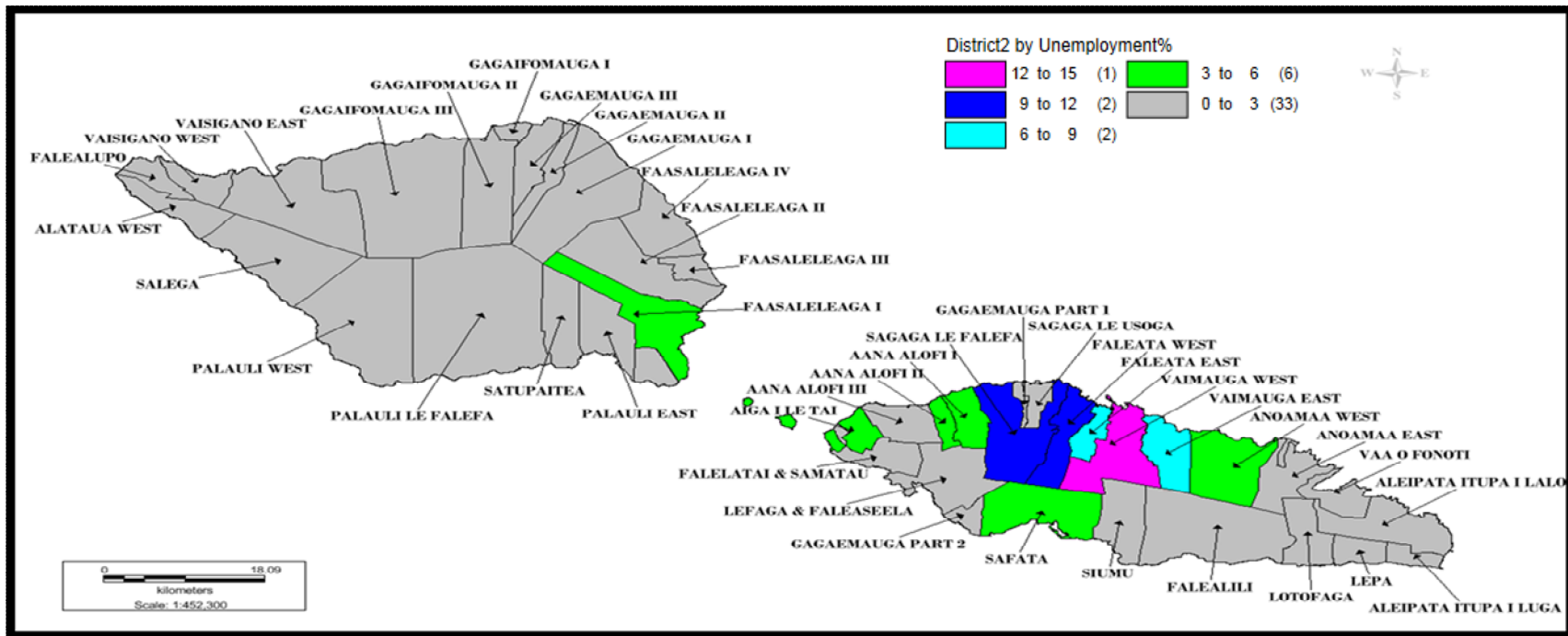




UNEMPLOYED POPULATION 15 YEARS AND OVER BY POLITICAL DISTRICT, 2011



The Population and Housing Census 2011 recorded that out of the total economically active population of **47,881** people aged 15yrs and above, about **6 percent** or **2,720 persons** were actively looking for a job or unemployed by the time of the Census. The map above shows the distribution of 6 percent or 2,720 people unemployed by political districts in percentages. The **first colour (pink)** shows only **1 political district** with the **highest percentage** of unemployed population ranging from **12-15 percent**. However the **last colour (grey)** shows that there are **33 political districts** with the **lowest percentage** of the unemployed population ranging from **0 to 3 percent**.

Out of the total unemployed population of 2,720, **83 percent** or **2,260** people lived on **Upolu Island** including (Manono and Apolima) while **17 percent** or **460** lived on **Savaii Island**.
