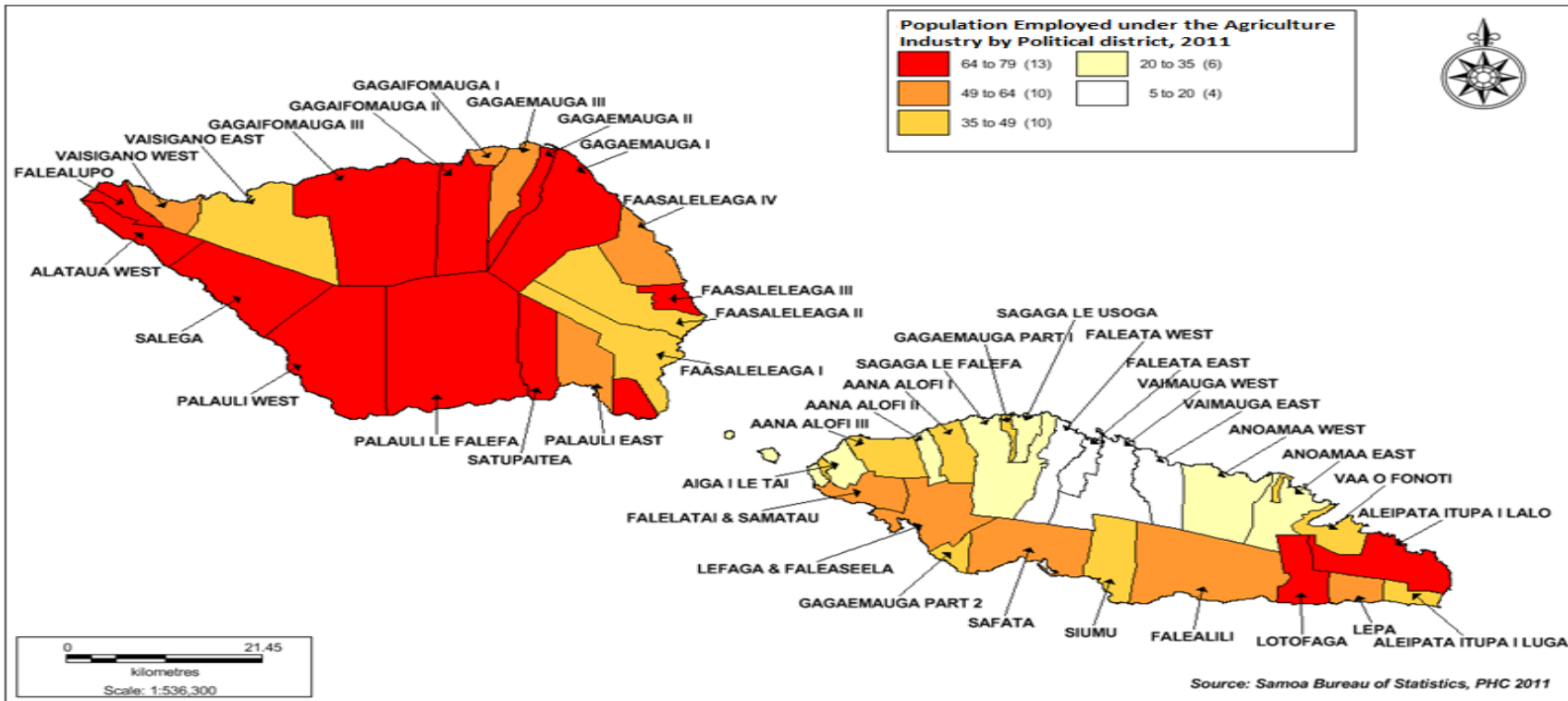


POPULATION EMPLOYED UNDER THE AGRICULTURE INDUSTRY BY POLITICAL DISTRICT, 2011



The Population and Housing Census 2011 reported that Samoa's **Employed Population** of 15 years and over was **45,161 persons**. Out of that total, **33 percent or 14,841 persons** were employed **under the Agriculture Industry**. The map above shows the distribution of **33 percent or 14,841 people** by political district in **percentage**. The map key tells that the **first colour red** indicates that there are **13 political districts with the highest percentage** of employees under the Agriculture Industry ranging from **64 - 79 percent** while the **last colour white** shows that there are **4 political districts with the lowest percentage** ranging from **5-20 percent**.

Overall, out of the total population of 14,841 employed in the Agriculture Industry, **55 percent or 8,115 persons** lived on Upolu Island including (*Manono and Apolima*) while the other **45 percent or 6,726 persons** lived on Savaii Island.
