
Percentage of Houses which used Cement as their main Wall Materials by Political Districts, 2011



There were **51,240 houses** enumerated in the Samoa Population and Housing Census 2011 and out of this number **20 percent or 10,312 houses used cement as their main wall materials**. The map above shows the distribution of 10,312 houses which used cement as wall materials by political districts and in **percentage**. **The first colour pink** tells that **12 political districts** have the **highest percentage** of houses with cement wall materials from the range of **20 to 34 percent** while the **last colour yellow** shows that **11 political districts** have the **lowest percentage** of houses with cement wall materials from a range of **8 to 14 percent**.

Overall out of 10,312 houses with cement wall materials in Samoa, **81 percent or 8,360 houses** were located on **Upolu island** including *(Manono and Apolima)* while **19 percent or 1,952 houses** were in the island of **Savaii**.
