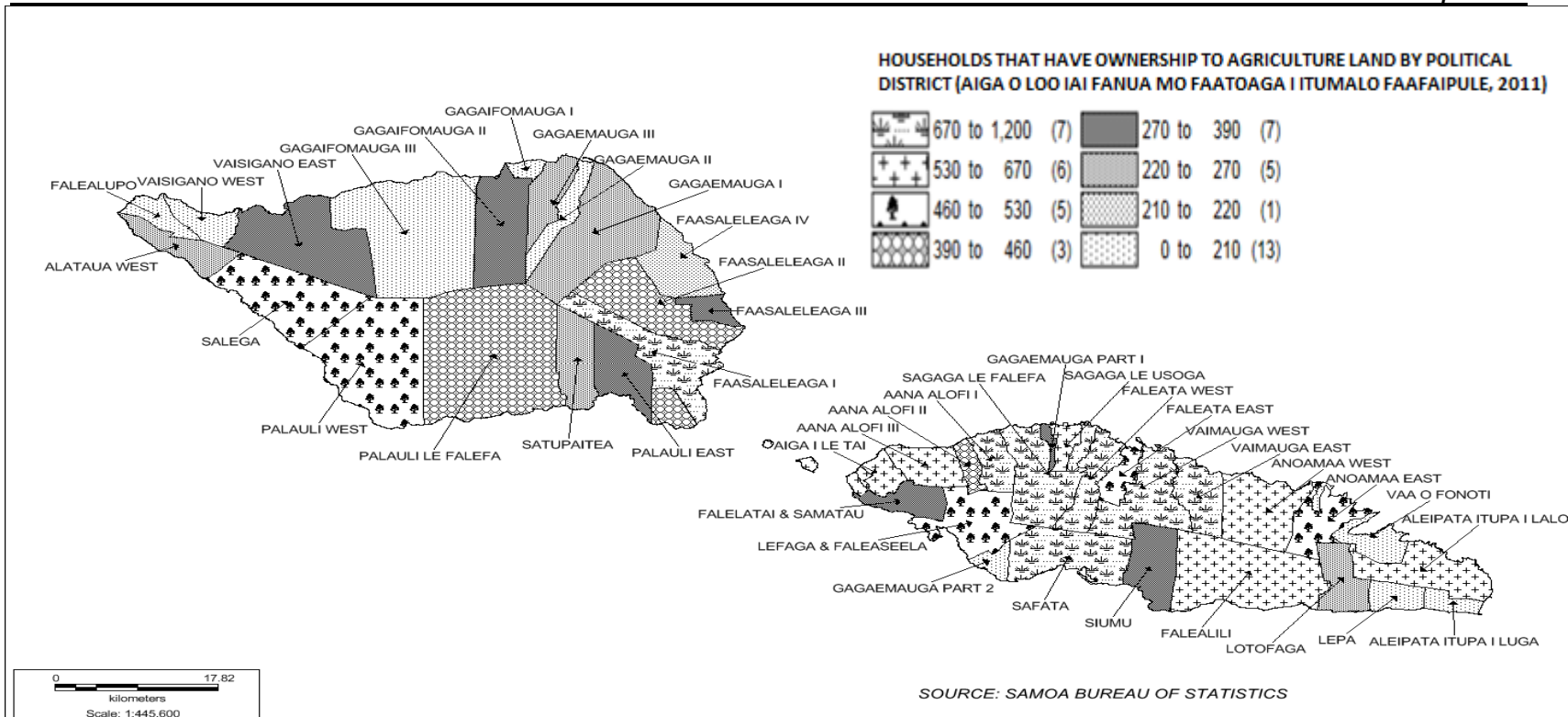


NUMBER OF HOUSEHOLDS THAT HAVE OWNERSHIP TO AGRICULTURE LAND BY POLITICAL DISTRICTS, 2011



It is reported in the Census 2011 that out of **26,205** households enumerated in 2011, about **71.5 percent** or **18,759** households have ownership to agriculture land. The above map shows the distribution of 18,759 households that have ownership to agriculture land by political district. The first pattern shows that there are **670 to 1200** households in **7 political districts** with the highest number of households that have ownership to agriculture land. In contrast to the last pattern, about **13 districts** have the lowest number of households (**0- 210**) that have ownership to agriculture land. Moreover, of the total number of household with ownership to agriculture land (18,759) **69 percent** or **(12,917) households** lived on Upolu Island (including Manono and Apolima) and **31% or (5,842)** lived on Savaii island.
