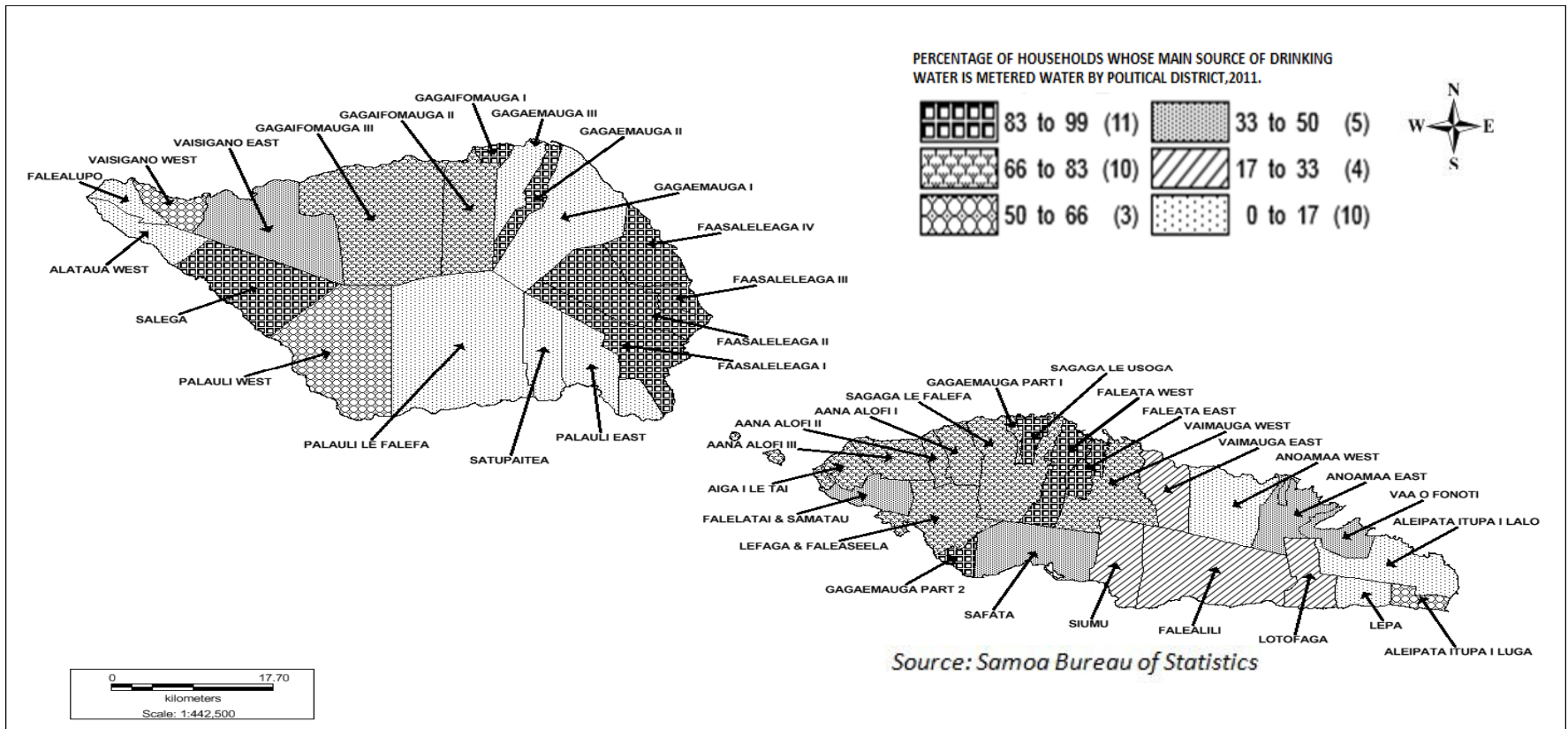


PERCENTAGE OF HOUSEHOLDS WHOSE MAIN SOURCE OF DRINKING WATER IS METERED WATER BY POLITICAL DISTRICTS, 2011



The Census of Population and Housing 2011 reported that out of **26,205** households, **62.3 percent** or **16,318 households** have metered water. The map shows the distribution of 16,318 households whose main source of drinking water is metered water in **percentage**. The first pattern explains that there are **11 political districts** with the highest percentage of households ranging from **(83 to 99) percent** whose main source of drinking water is metered water. However the last pattern shows that there are **10 political districts** with the lowest range of **(0 to 17) percent of households** that have metered their water. Overall, of the total number of households with metered water (16,318) about **78.5 percent** or **12,811 households** in Upolu (including Manono and Apolima) have metered water compared to only **21.5 percent** or **3,507 households** in Savaii.
