What is CRVS??

Civil Registration is the act of recording of vital events in people's life including births, deaths, adoptions, marriages and divorces.

Importance of CRVS

- Ongoing awareness with Villages and Church Representatives




Link With MOH/NHS/MWCSD

ncient statistical system providing relevant, quality statistics for the benefit of Samoa'




But registration often does not happen until children start school

Deaths are only registered by families when there is an incentive (such as insurance claims)
