CONSUMER PRICE INDEX JUNE 2024

In June 2024 compared with June 2023:

- The Consumer Price Index increased by 0.8%
- The most significant price rises were:
- ✓ Transport (0.3%)
- ✓ Food & Non Alcoholic beverages (0.3%)

- The Average Annual Inflation was 3.6%
- The CPI declined 0.5% from May 2024

SUMMARY


The Consumer Price Index (CPI) for June 2024 rose 0.8 percent compared to June 2023. It fell 0.5 percent compared to May 2024.

Transport and Food & Non-Alcoholic Beverages were the largest contributors to the 0.8 percent rise in the CPI in June 2024.

The **Imported** goods component of the CPI registered a slight decrease of 0.1 percent when compared to the same month last year. This was mainly driven by lower prices of housing material, sport shoes and toiletries supply.

The **Local** goods component recorded an increase in prices of koko Samoa and fresh produce such as Chinese cabbage, tomato and round cabbage. This has resulted in the 1.8 percent rise.

Graph 1 shows the percentage changes over the same month of the previous year in the CPI by all Divisions from June 2023 to June 2024.

Total All Divisions Contribution

Transport was the largest contributor to the 0.8 percent rise in the CPI in June 2024, with a contribution of 0.3 percentage points. This was mainly influenced by the increase in prices of a new double cab pickup (up 22.7%), return boat fare to Pago Pago (up 16.7%), return air fare to Pagopago (up 11%) and petrol (up 1.6%).

Food & Non-Alcoholic Beverages was the next largest contributor with a contribution of 0.3 percentage points, increasing 0.6 percent compared to June 2023. The most significant drivers of this within the group were chicken leg quarter (up 2.6%), sugar (up 4.3%), rice (up 12.0%), chocolate cake (up 17.4%), local coffee (up 13.3%), koko Samoa (up to 30.1%), Chinese cabbage (up 23.1%), cucumber (up 21.0%), tomato (up 83.9%) and round cabbage (up 47.5%).

Alcoholic beverages, tobacco & narcotics contributed 0.2 percentage-points, increasing 1.8 percent when compared with June 2023 as a result of the increase in the prices of cigarettes (up 4.1%) and Samoan kava (up 6.3%).

Furnishings, household equipment and Maintenance contributed 0.2 percentage-points, increasing 7.6 percent when compared with June 2023 as a result of the increase in the prices of mattress (up 32.2%) and bush knife (up 15.9%).

Communication contributed 0.1 percentage points, increasing 1.3 percent when compared to June 2023.










Graph 2 shows the percentage contribution of All Divisions to CPI in June 2024.


Consumer Price Index (% Change)

Health had the largest increase of 14.9 percent. Furnishings household equipment & Maintenance rose 7.9 percent followed by Recreation & Culture which rose 6.7 percent. Food & Non-Alcoholic and Restaurants & hotels both increased by 5.5 percent and 2.1 percent respectively.

Other groups such as Transport, Communication, Alcoholic beverages, tobacco & narcotics and Miscellaneous recorded increases of 1.7, 1.3, 0.6, and 0.1 percent respectively.

On the other hand, Clothing & Footwear and Housing, water, electricity, gas & other fuels declined by 0.7 percent and 0.5 percent while the Education index revealed no change.

Changes by Division / Group

Health Index

The 11.6 percent increase in the Health Index was driven by higher prices recorded for medicine (amoxicillin tablets) which went up by 8.9%.

Furnishings, Household Equipment & Maintenance Index

The Furnishings, Household Equipment & Maintenance index rose 7.6 percent due to the increase in prices of single mattress (up 32.2%), bush knife (up to 15.9%) washing soap (up 9.0%) and refrigerator (up 6.7%).

Recreation and Culture Index

The Recreation and Culture index went up by 7.2 percent due to the increase in prices of exercise book (up 17.0%), laptop (up 9.7%) and newspaper (up 15.0%).

Restaurants Index

The Restaurants index recorded an increase of 2.1 percent due to higher prices for fish & chips (up 2.2%) and steamed rice chicken meal (up 5.0%).

Transport

The Transport Index rose 2.0 percent due to the increase in the prices of a new double cab pickup (up 22.7%), return boat fare to Pago Pago (up 16.7%), return air fare to Pagopago (up 11%) and petrol (up 1.6%).

Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco Index

The increase in prices of cigarettes and Samoan kava contributed primarily to the 1.8 percent increase in the Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco index.

Communication Index

The increase in prices of mobile phone calling per minute (up 7.3%) was the major contributor to the 1.3 percent increase in the Communication index.

Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages Index

The increase of 0.6 percent in the Food & Non-Alcoholic Beverages index reflected higher prices of chicken leg quarter (up 2.6%), sugar (up 4.3%), rice (up 12.0%), chocolate cake (up 17.4%), local coffee (up 13.3%), koko Samoa (up to 30.1%), Chinese cabbage (up 23.1%), cucumber (up 21.0%), tomato (up 83.9%) and round cabbage (up 47.5%).

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels Index

The decline in prices for gas, cement and timber has led to a 3.2 percent decrease in the Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels index.

Clothing and Footwear Index

The 1.8 percent decrease in the Clothing and Footwear index reflected lower prices recorded for branded running shoes.

Miscellaneous Goods and Services Index

The lower prices recoded for toiletries led to the decline of 0.3 percent in the Miscellaneous Goods & Services index.

Education

The Education index remained unchanged when compared to June 2023.


Underlying Indices 1/

The All Items Underlying Index for June 2024 recorded an increase of 0.1 percent when compared to June 2023. It was 1.5 percent lower when compared to May 2024. The Imported items Underline index decreased by 0.6 percent, while the Local items underlying Index on the other hand increased by 1.8 percent.

Annual Inflation Rate

The average annual inflation rate for the year ended June 2024 was 3.6 percent. For the twelve months ending June 2023, the inflation rate was 12.0 percent.

Technical Notes:

The Consumer Price (CPI) measures the rate of inflation for Samoa. It is designed to measure the change in prices for the goods purchased by households in Samoa. The CPI measures the change in prices by comparing the prices for a basket of goods and services at the collection period with the price for the same goods in a base period.

The basket of goods that is priced is based on the average expenditures of households as recorded in the Household Income and Expenditure Survey (HIES). The HIES survey identifies how much households spend on different items. The more households spend on an item on average, the more important it is to the price index, and the higher the weight in the index.

^{1/} Monthly movements in the 'headline' CPI series can be volatile. This volatility reflects price changes in particular items that may be due, among other factors, to fluctuations in commodity markets and agricultural conditions, policy changes, or seasonal or infrequent price resetting.

Underlying inflation is a measure of inflation that excludes certain items that face volatile price movements. Underlying inflation eliminates products that can have temporary price shocks because these shocks can diverge from the overall trend of inflation and give a false measure of inflation.




