Highlights of the Month

August 2024 compared with July 2024

Merchandise Exports¹

- ❖ The total value of exports in August 2024 increased by 77.4 percent (or \$4.7 million) to \$10.8 million. This was due to the increases in the exports and re-exports of:
 - ❖ Electrical machinery and equipment products (up \$4.3 million)
 - ❖ Fats and oils products (up \$0.4 million)
 - ❖ Vegetables and certain roots and tubers products (up \$0.1 million)
 - ❖ Iron and steel products (up \$0.1 million)
- ❖ Exports to Oceania of \$5.2 million had the largest share of 47.7 percent of total exports in the period under review, increasing 31.4 percent compared to the preceding month.
- ❖ Exports to Singapore of \$3.9 million (up \$3.7 million), New Zealand of \$1.8 million (up \$0.3 million), Australia of \$1.4 million (up \$0.4 million) and USA of \$1.3 million (up \$0.5 million) had the largest increases in August 2024, reflecting higher exports of telephone equipment (repeaters), coconut oil and taro exports to name a few.

Merchandise Imports

- ❖ The total value of imports increased by 13.4 percent (or \$15.3 million) in August 2024 to \$128.9 million. This was mainly driven by the increases of:
 - ❖ Mineral fuels, mineral oils and products (up \$13.5 million)
 - ❖ Electrical machinery and equipment & parts (up \$4.8 million)
 - ❖ Vehicles other than railway (up \$3.2 million)
 - ❖ Optical, photographic apparatus, parts and accessories (up \$2.2 million)
- ❖ Imports from the Oceania region of \$62.8 million recorded the largest increase in August 2024 (up \$14.6 million), mainly due to the importation of scanning and screening machines from New Zealand to name a few.
- ❖ Imports from New Zealand of \$36.5 million (up \$12.2 million), Singapore of \$29.7 million (up \$13.3 million) and Australia of \$15.0 million (up \$1.9 million) had the largest increases in the reviewed month resulting from higher imports of scanning/screening machines, petroleum products, vehicle and parts and food products such as sugar and chicken leg quarter to name a few.

Trade Balance

- ❖ The total value of imports of \$128.9 million exceeded exports of \$10.8 million, resulting in a trade deficit of \$118.1 million in August 2024. The trade deficit increased by 9.8 percent and 17.6 percent when compared to its balance in the previous month and the same month last year respectively.

 - ❖ Taavale, vaega ma isi mea faaopopo (siitia i le \$3.2 miliona)
 - ❖ Masini ma meafaigaluega mo su'esu'ega tau ata (siitia i le \$2.2 miliona)
- ❖ O le itulagi o Oseania na faamauina e \$62.8 miliona le tau aofai o oloa na auina mai ai ia Aukuso 2024 (siitia i le \$14.6 miliona) mafua mai i masini ma mea faigaluega faaogaina i su'esu'ega tau fā'ata mai Niu Sila ma isi oloa.
- ❖ O le tau aofai o oloa auina mai i Niu Sila e \$36.5 miliona (siitia i le \$12.2 miliona), Sigapoa e \$29.7 miliona (siitia i le \$13.3 miliona) ma Ausetalia e \$15.0 miliona (siitia i le \$1.9 miliona) na faamauina le siitia i le masina o Aukuso 2024. E mafua mai i oloa e pei o masini mo su'esu'ega, oloa tau suā'u, taavale ma ona vaega faapea meaai e pei o moa, suka ma isi oloa.

O lenei paleni na faamauina le siitia i le 9.8 pasene ma le 17.6 pasene pe'ā faatusa i le masina o lulai 2024 ma le masina o Aukuso 2023.



The main source of imports and exports data comes from the administrative document; a completed customs form (Single Administrative data-SAD) which is required to be filled in by importers and exporters or customs agents when clearing merchandise inward and outward through the Ministry of Customs and Revenue.

The September 2024 Merchandise trade report is expected to be available on October 14th 2024.
