IMPORT PRICE INDEX – JUNE 2022 QUARTER (Base Period: March 2018 quarter = 100.0)

Highlights of the quarter

(June 2022 quarter compared with March 2022 quarter)

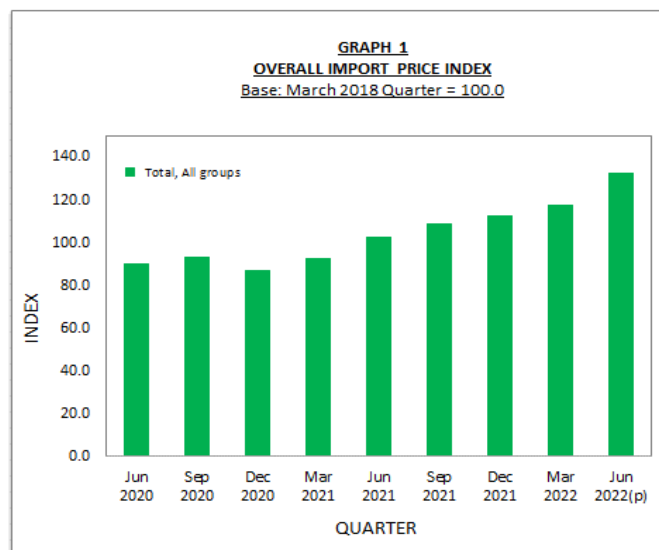
- Import Price Index increased 12.6 percent from March 2022 quarter.
- Mineral products recorded the largest increase (up 24.0 percent).

Overview

The Import Price Index for the June 2022 quarter showed an overall increase of 12.6 percent from the previous quarter. This surge was mainly driven by the 24.0 percent increase in the price of mineral products. When compared to the June 2021 quarter, the import price index increased 29.3 percent.

The overall import price index for the four quarters ending June 2022 increased by 25.6 percent when compared to the four quarters ending June 2021.

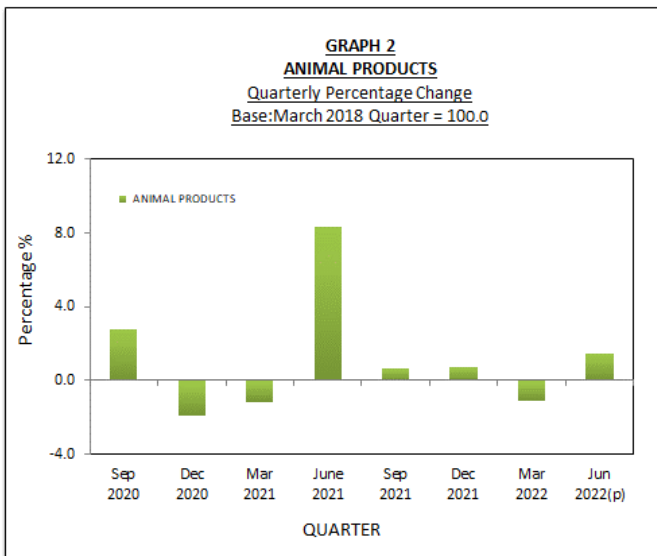

HS Section 1: Live Animals; Animal Product price rose 1.5%.

Import price index for Live Animal Products in the June 2022 quarter rose 1.5 percent from the previous quarter. This was led by the increase of 1.6 percent of meat products as a result of the increase in prices of chicken meat (up 1.8 percent). In addition, dairy products rose 1.2 percent as a result of higher prices of liquid milk (up 2.4 percent) and powder milk (up 1.3 percent). When compared to the June 2021 quarter, the live animals and animal product index increased 1.7 percent.

The four-quarters ending June 2022 showed an increase of 6.0 percent in the overall index for live animals and animal products over the four-quarters ending June 2021.

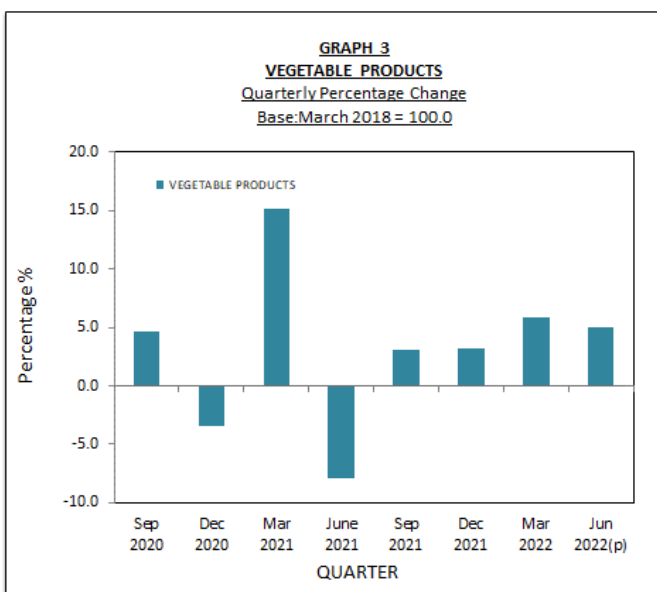

HS Section 2: Vegetable Products prices rose 5.0%.

Import price index for Vegetable Products in the June 2022 quarter increased 5.0 percent over the previous quarter. This was due to higher import prices of vegetables such as potatoes (up 33.6 percent) and onions (up 4.5 percent). Moreover, the import price for milled products rose 4.8 percent. When compared to the same quarter last year, the vegetable products index increased 18.3 percent.

The overall index in the four quarters ending June 2022 increased 10.0 percent when compared to the four quarters ending June 2021. (See tables 1 & 2 and graph 3).

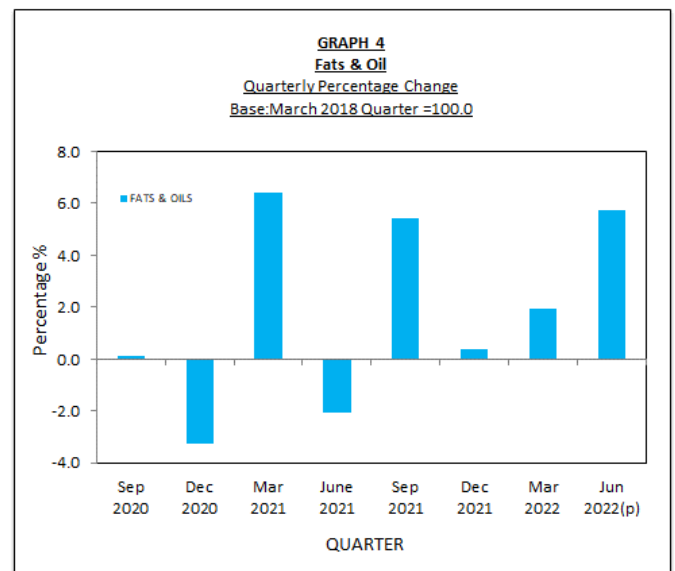

HS Section 3: Animal or Vegetable fats & oils prices increased 5.8%.

Animal or Vegetable fats and oils import price index increased 5.8 percent in the June 2022 quarter, reflecting higher import prices of vegetable oil (up 24.3 percent) and sunflower oil (up 0.6 percent). In comparison with the June 2021 quarter, the animal or vegetable fats and oils index increased 14.2 percent.

The four quarters ending June 2022 increased by 9.1 percent when compared to the four quarters ending June 2021. (See tables 1 & 2 and graph 4).



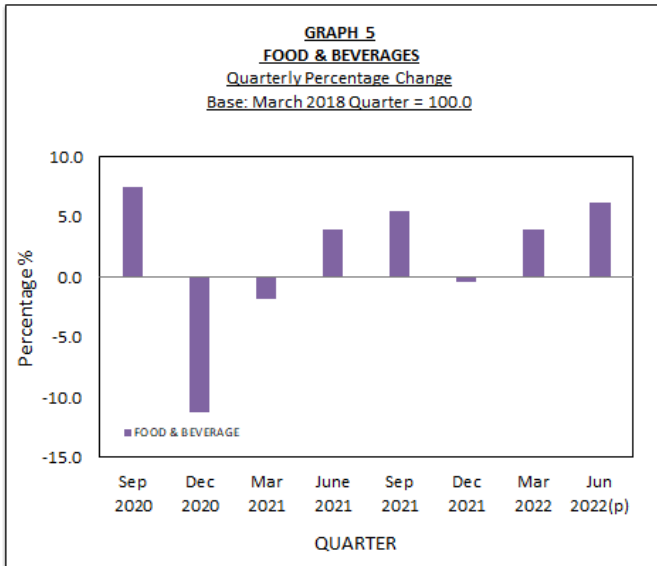

HS Section 4: Food and Beverage prices rose 6.1%.

In the June 2022 quarter, the Food and Beverage import price index increased 6.1 percent compared to the previous quarter. This increase was driven by higher prices of pastrycook products (up 11.9 percent) and canned meats (up 1.7 percent). In comparison with the corresponding quarter of 2021, the food and beverage index further increased by 15.9 percent.

The overall Food and Beverage index increased 7.6 percent in the four quarters ending June 2022 when compared to the same period ending June 2021.

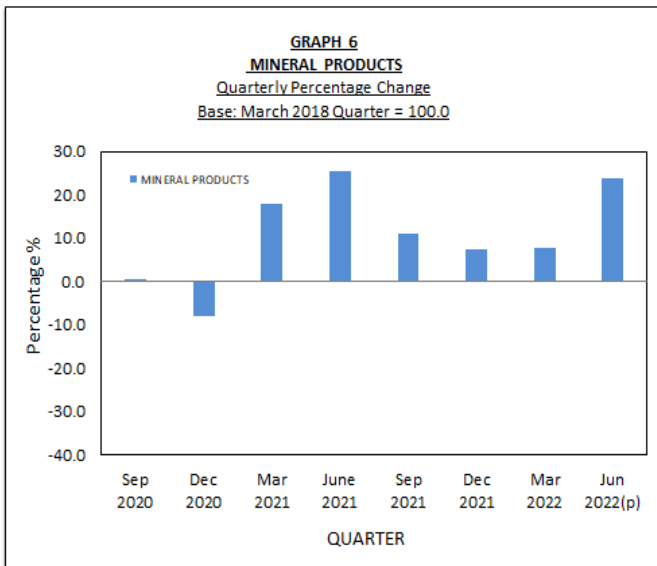

HS Section 5: Mineral Products price increased 24.0%.

Import price index for Mineral Products rose 24.0 percent in the June 2022 quarter, following a 7.6 percent increase in the March 2022 quarter. This increase was driven by higher prices of petroleum oils (up 26.2 percent) and petroleum gases (up 6.1 percent). When compared to the June 2021 quarter, the mineral products index rose 59.6 percent. The index in the four-quarters ending June 2022 increased by 61.9 percent over the four-quarters ending June 2021. (See tables 1 & 2 and graph 6).

Technical Notes

The Import Price Index (MPI) measures changes in the cost, insurance, and freight (CIF) prices of imports of merchandise into Samoa. It is a fixed weight index with March 2018 quarter = 100.0 and is calculated on a quarterly basis using the International Harmonized System of Trade Classification (HS). The items included in the index were selected on the basis of their importance to the total import.


The scope of the MPI relates to the following sections of the International Harmonized System of Trade Classification (HS): 1. Live Animals: Animal Products, 2. Vegetable Products, 3. Animal or Vegetable fats and oils, 4. Food and Beverages and 5. Mineral Products. The index represents 50 percent of total Imports.

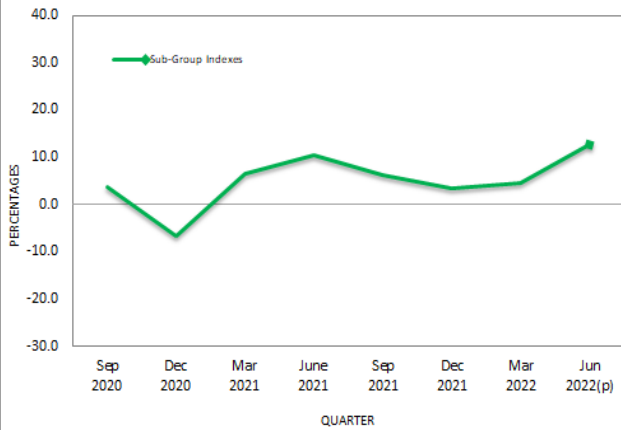

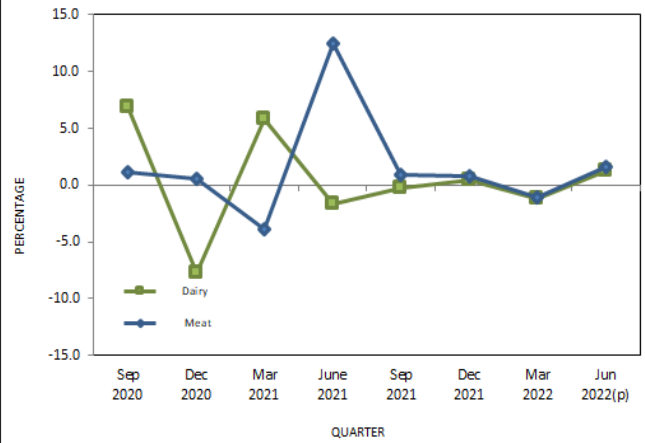

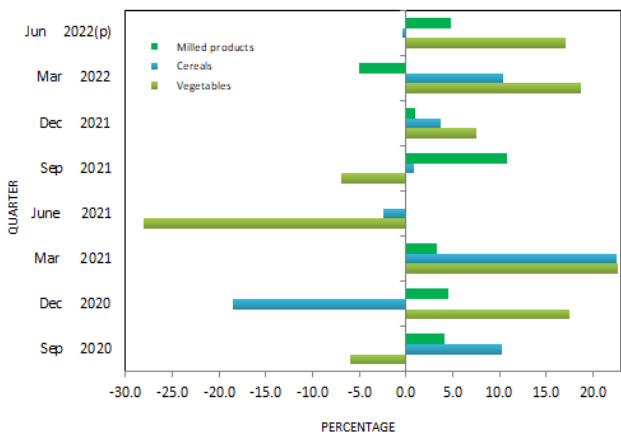
GRAPH 7

 Base: March 2018 Quarter = 100.0



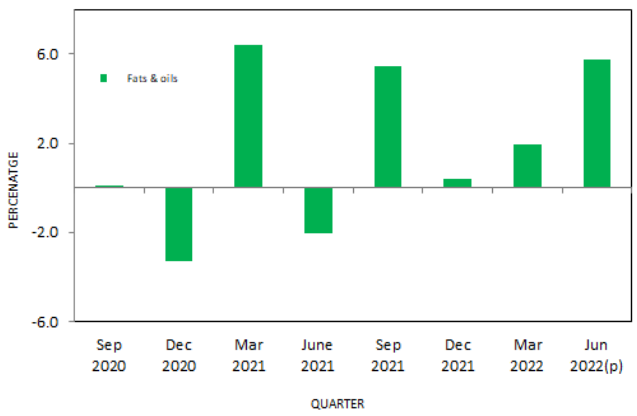
GRAPH 8

 Base: March 2018 Quarter = 100.0



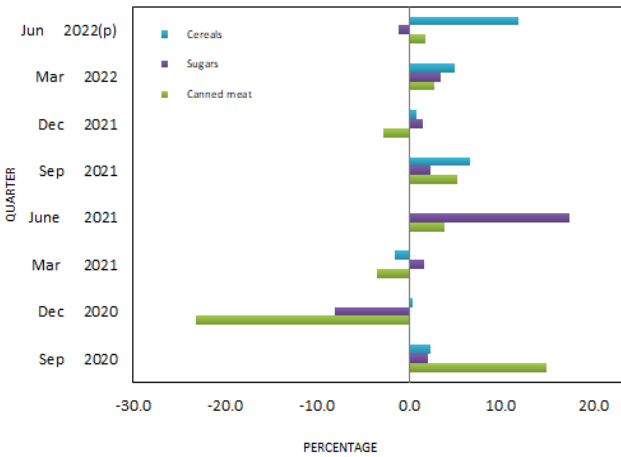
