
1. TOTAL ARRIVALS

The total International Arrival Statistics recorded for the month of <u>May 2023</u> totalling 21,796 arrivals, revealed a increase of 13.7 percent over the previous month of April 2023.

Those who travelled to Samoa by Air represented 94.8% while 5.2% was represented by those who travelled by Sea.

Fig. 1 below graphically depicts the arrival numbers from May 2014 to May 2023, clearly showing the impact of Covid 19 on arrival numbers between April 2020 and July 2022, with international borders reopening in August 2022.

Fig. 1: May Total Arrivals, 2014 - 2023




### 2. TOTAL VISITORS

Overall visitor numbers for the month under review stood at 15,719, revealing an increase of 14.6 percent over the previous month of April 2023

Fig 2 shows the visitor numbers from May 2014 to May 2023, visibly showing the impacts of Covid 19 on monthly visitors numbers between April 2020 and July 2022.

Fig. 2: May Total Visitors, 2014 - 2023




#### 3. TOTAL ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF ENTRY

Visitors, (Table 2), made up the largest component of all arrivals with 67.3 percent (14,674), represented by 34.7 percent females (7,574) and 32.6 percent males (7,100).

Male returning residents made up 18.0 percent (3,924) of total arrivals while their female counterpart made up 9.9 percent (2,153). (Refer Fig. 3)

Fig. 3: Total Arrivals, by Purpose of Entry, May 2023





#### 4. TOTAL VISITORS BY COUNTRY OF USUAL RESIDENCE

New Zealand remains as the leading country in visitors' arrival by country of usual residence (Table 3) accounting for 43.9 percent of total visitors or 6,902 visitors. Australia followed next with a distant 28.6 percent share (4,495).

United States of America reported 7.9 percent (1,247 visitors) while American Samoa reported 5.2 percent (819) of total visitors. (Refer Fig. 4)

Fig. 4: Total Visitors, by Country of Usual Residence, May 2023




#### 5. TOTAL VISITORS BY REGION

As usual, the Oceanic Region had the highest share of total visitors with 83.0 percent, followed by America with 8.1 percent.

Asia reported a share of 6.6 percent while Europe reported the least share of 2.0 percent. (Refer Fig. 5).

Fig. 5: Total Visitors by Region, May 2023




#### 6. TOTAL VISITORS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT

The principal source markets (Table 4) namely New Zealand, Australia, American Samoa and the United States of America constituted 85.6 percent of all visitors visiting Samoa in May 2023.

The majority of visitors (6,070) entered our shores to visits friends and relatives while (5,891) entered our shores for holiday and vacation.

Those who were here for Business/ Conference recorded (1,397) visitors while those on transit reported (411) visitors. Fig.6 depicts total visitors by purpose of visit for May 2019 (pre Covid 19) and May 2023 (post Covid 19).

Fig. 6: Total Visitors, by Purpose of Visit, May 2019 & May 2023




#### 7. TOTAL ARRIVALS BY CARRIER

As depicted in table 5, Air New Zealand carried the highest share of passengers to Samoa with a 43.7 percent share, (9,530 passengers) followed by Fiji Airways with a 19.6 percent share (4,281 passengers).


Fig. 7: Total Arrivals by Carrier, May 2023

Virgin Australia brought in 12.4 percent (2,562 passengers) of total arrivals while Quantas and Samoa Airways recorded shares of 7.4 percent (1,607) and 5.7 percent (1,232) respectively. Fig. 7 illustrates total arrivals by carrier during the reference period.

#### 8. TOTAL VISITORS BY DURATION OF STAY AND PLACE OF STAY

As shown in Fig. 8 below, visitor's duration of stay in Samoa (Table 6) is between seven and thirty days.

On the other hand, the majority of visitors (59.6 percent or 9,131 visitors) reported staying in private accommodations or with families/ relatives while 36.0 percent (5,511) stayed in hotel/ motel. (Refer Fig. 9).

Fig. 9: Total Visitors by Place of Stay, May 2023





Fig. 10 portrays the number of visitors who stayed in hotels/motels (5,511) by type of accommodation (hotel/motel), within the reference month.

These forms are completed by all incoming and outgoing travelers at the two local points of entry namely:


- (1) Faleolo International Airport

International Arrival Statistics are compiled on a monthly, quarterly and annual basis. These reports can also be extracted from our website: www.sbs.gov.ws



Graph 3: Visitors Percentage Change over Previous month, May 2018 - May 2023


