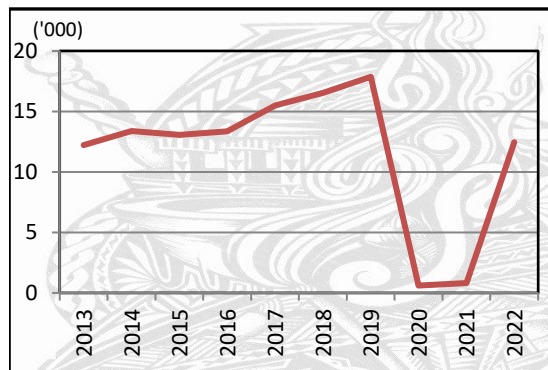
1. TOTAL ARRIVALS

The total International Arrival Statistics recorded for the month of **November 2022**, revealed an increase of 13.4 percent over the previous month and recorded a total of 12,442 arrivals.

Table 1 reveals that only 12,442 passengers arrived during the reference month. Those that travelled to Samoa by Air represented 92.4% while 7.6% was represented by those that travelled by Sea.

Fig 1 below graphically depicts the arrival numbers from November 2013 to November 2022, clearly showing the impact of Covid 19 on arrival numbers since the beginning of 2020, otherwise the numbers started to increase in 2022.

Fig. 1: November Total Arrivals, 2013 – 2022

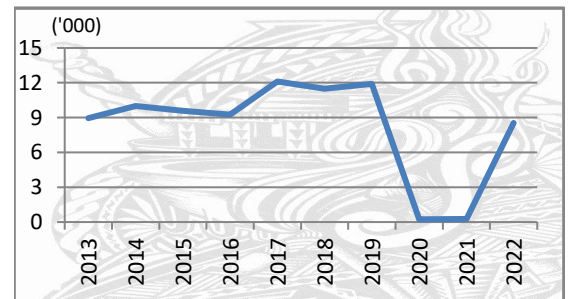


2. TOTAL VISITORS

Table 1 further reveals that 8,530 visitors entered our shores during the month under review revealed an increase of 19.0 percent over the previous month. (Refer Fig. 2)

Fig 2 shows the visitor numbers from November 2013 to November 2022, also showing the impact of Covid 19 on visitor numbers since the beginning of 2020.

Fig. 2: November Total Visitors, 2013 – 2022



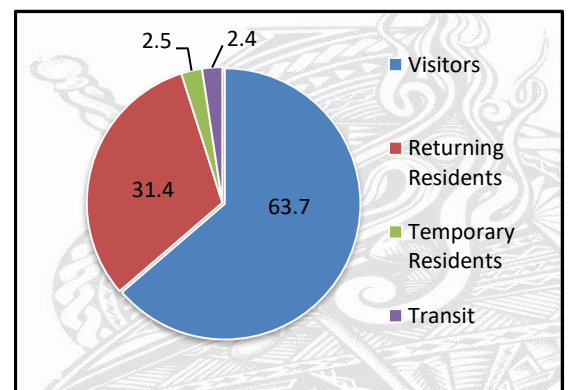
3. TOTAL ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF ENTRY

Visitors, (table 2), made up the largest component of all arrivals with 31.6 percent (3,935) represented by males and 32.0 percent (3,986) by females.

Male returning residents made up 17.8 percent (2,213) of total arrivals while their female counterpart made up 13.7 percent (1,699). (Refer Fig. 3)

Fig. 3: Total Arrivals, by Purpose of Entry, November 2022



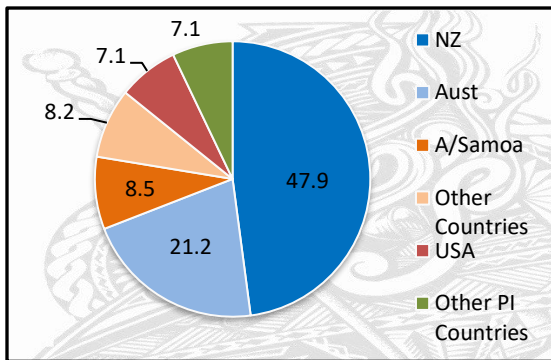

4. TOTAL VISITORS BY COUNTRY OF USUAL RESIDENCE

New Zealand remains as the leading country in visitors' arrival by country of usual residence (Table 3) accounting for 47.9 percent of total visitors or 4,090 visitors. Australia followed next with a distant 21.2 percent share (1,810).

American Samoa represented 8.5 percent (726) while the United States of America represented 7.1 percent (607) of total visitors. (Refer Fig. 4)

Fig. 4: Total Visitors, by Country of Usual Residence, November 2022

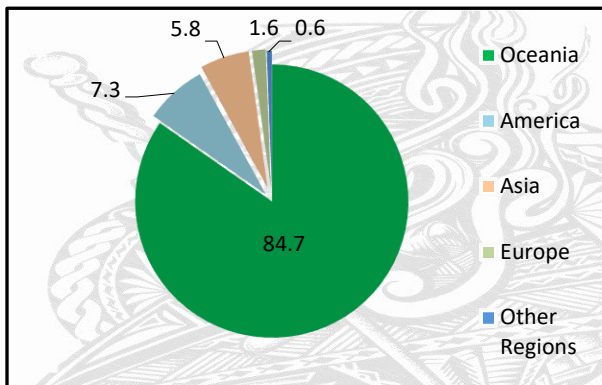


5. TOTAL VISITORS BY REGION

As usual, the Oceanic Region had the highest share of total visitors with 84.7 percent, followed by America with 7.3 percent.

Asia reported a share of 5.8 percent while Europe reported the least share of 1.6 percent. (Refer Fig. 5).

Fig. 5: Total Visitors by Region, November 2022



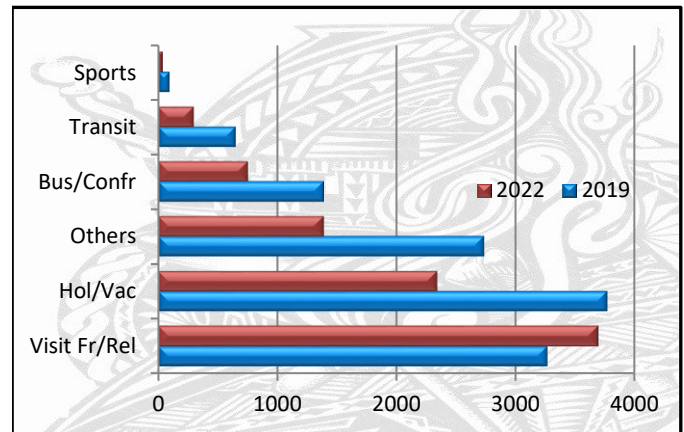
6. TOTAL VISITORS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT

The principal source markets (Table 4) namely New Zealand, Australia, American Samoa and the United States of America constituted 84.8 percent of all visitors visiting Samoa in November 2022.

The majority of visitors (43.3 percent) entered our shores to visit friends and relatives while 27.5 percent entered our shores for holiday and vacation.

Those who were here for Business/ Conference recorded a share of 8.8 percent while those on transit made up 3.5 percent. Fig.6 depicts total visitors by purpose of visit for November 2019 and November 2022.

Fig. 6: Total Visitors, by Purpose of Visit, November 2019 & November 2022

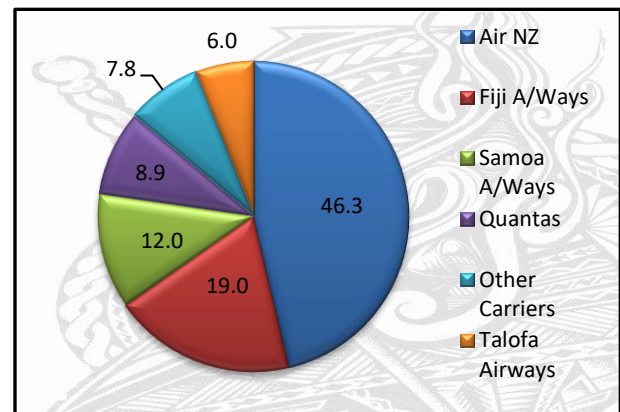


7. TOTAL ARRIVALS BY CARRIER

As depicted in table 5, Air New Zealand carried the highest share of passengers to Samoa with a 46.3 percent share, (5,759 passengers) followed by Fiji Airways with a 19.0 percent share (2,363 passengers).

Samoa Airways brought in 12.0 percent (1,490 passengers) of total arrivals while Quantas and Talofa Airways recorded shares of 8.9 percent (1,106) and 6.0 percent (748) respectively. Fig. 7 illustrates total arrivals by carrier during the reference period.

Fig. 7: Total Arrivals by Carrier, November 2022

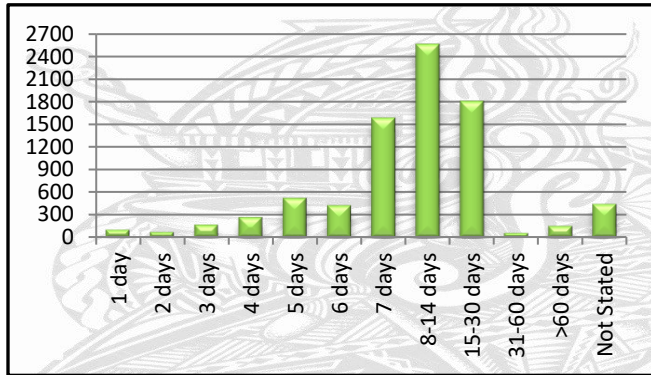

8. TOTAL VISITORS BY DURATION OF STAY AND PLACE OF STAY

As shown in Fig. 8 below, visitor's duration of stay in Samoa (Table 6) is between seven and thirty days.

On the other hand, the majority of visitors (60.5 percent or 4,980 visitors) reported staying in private accommodations or with families/ relatives while 28.7 percent (2,363) stayed in hotel/ motel. (Refer Fig. 9).

Fig. 9: Total Visitors by Place of Stay, November 2022

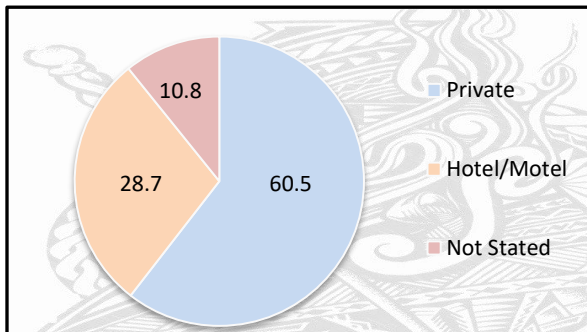
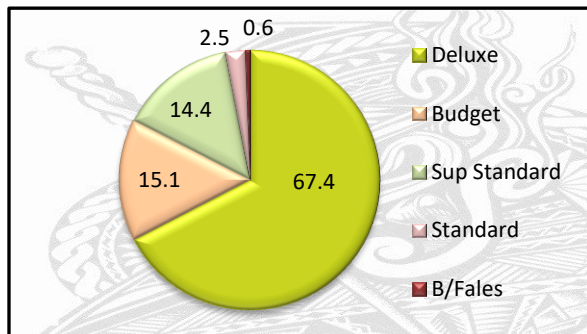


Fig. 10 portrays the number of visitors who stayed in hotels/ motels (2,363) by type of accommodation (hotel/ motel), within the reference month.

- (2) Apia Wharf (Matautu Port)

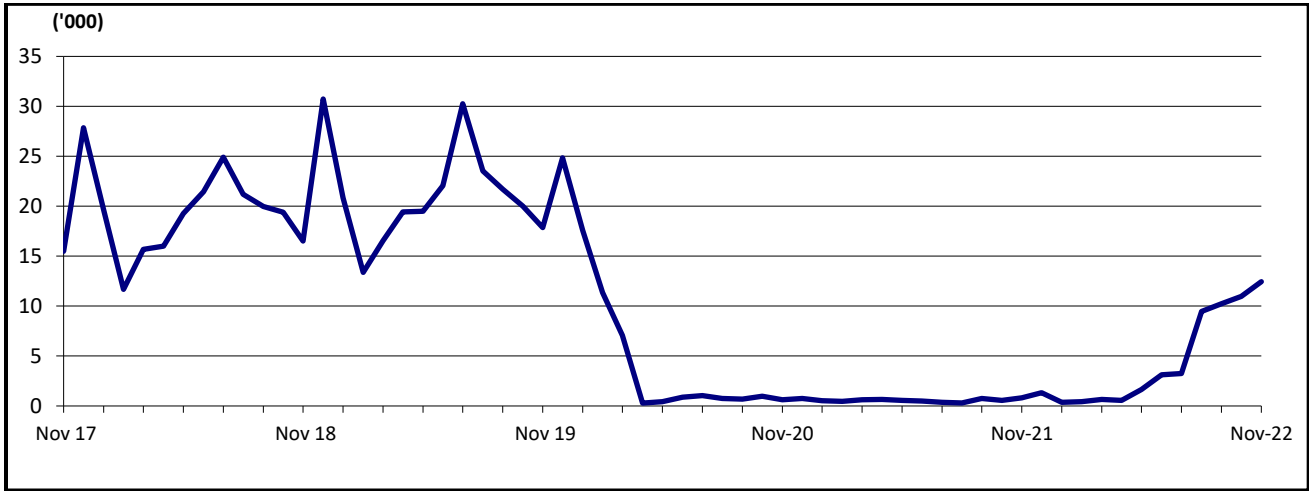
International Arrival Statistics are compiled on a monthly, quarterly and annual basis. These reports can also be extracted from our website: www.sbs.gov.ws

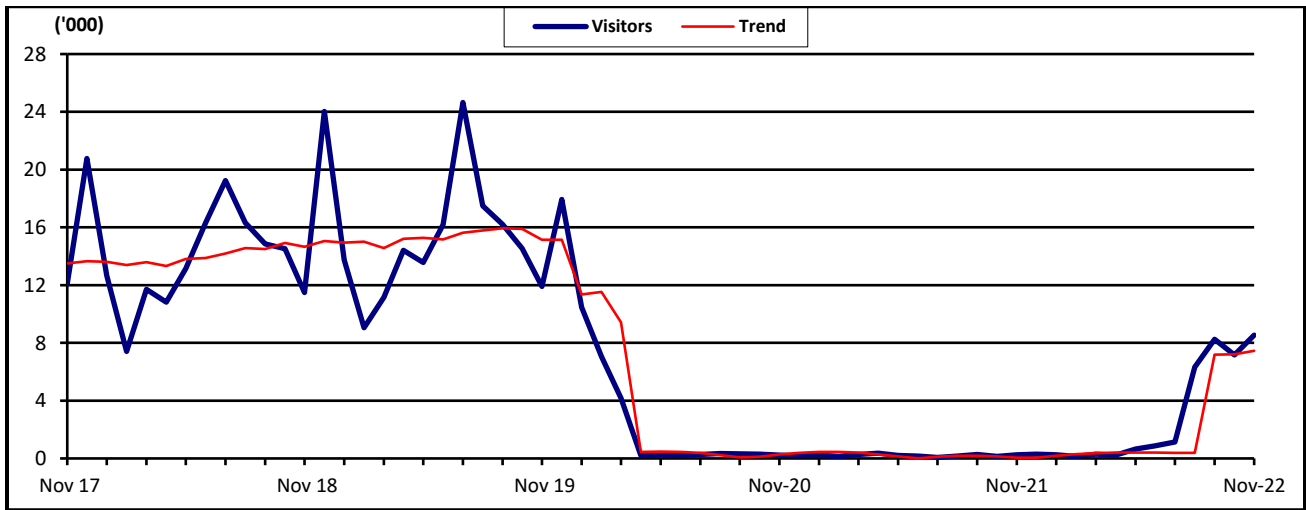

Graph 3: Visitors Percentage Change over Previous month, November 2017 – November 2022

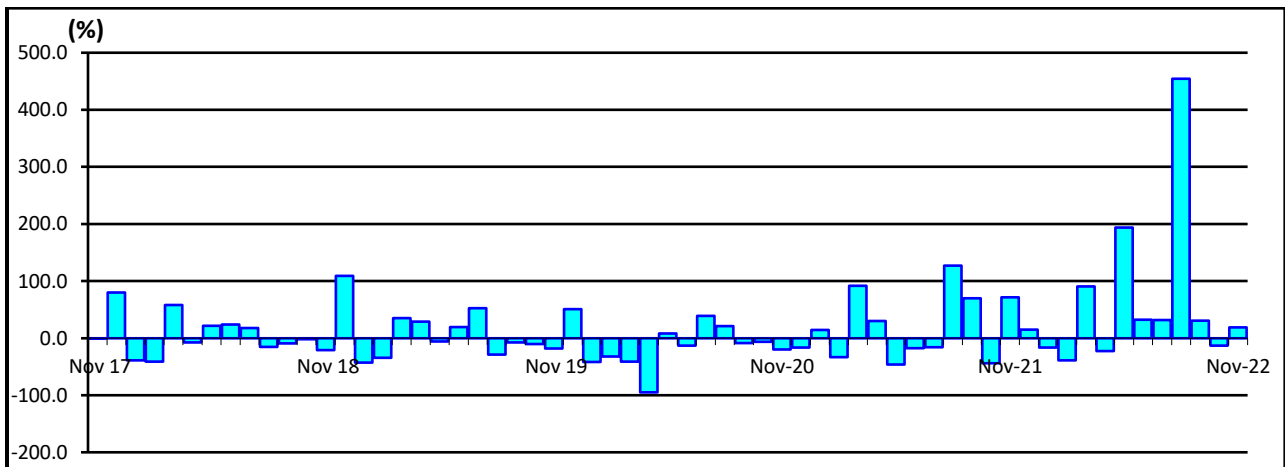
